

Expansion of QR Code Boarding for the ALL SHIKOKU Rail Pass, Revisions to Pass Benefits, and Discontinuation of the KAGAWA Mini Rail & Ferry Pass

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Shikoku Railway Company

JR Shikoku, together with the railway and tram operators of Shikoku, will introduce a QR code*-based ticketing service for the ALL SHIKOKU Rail Pass, a special rail pass for international visitors to Japan, in partnership with Trip.com Group Limited ("Trip.com"), beginning October 1, 2026. In addition, the ALL SHIKOKU Rail Pass will be updated with revised coverage, pass types, and selected fare changes. Sales of the KAGAWA Mini Rail & Ferry Pass will end on September 30, 2026.

1. Expansion of QR Code Ticketing for the ALL SHIKOKU Rail Pass

Beginning October 1, 2026, QR code ticketing for the ALL SHIKOKU Rail Pass will also be available through Trip.com. Since April 2025, the ALL SHIKOKU Rail Pass has supported QR code ticketing through a partnership with Klook. With the addition of Trip.com, customers will likewise be able to board trains by scanning their QR code directly at automatic ticket gates, eliminating the need to exchange their purchase for a paper ticket and providing a seamless travel experience.

**Passengers who purchase the pass through existing sales channels, including travel agencies and station ticket offices, will still be required to exchange their purchase for a paper ticket.*

2. Revisions to the ALL SHIKOKU Rail Pass

(1) Effective Date of the Revisions

Effective for passes issued on or after October 1, 2026

** For overseas sales, the effective date is based on the local date of purchase.*

(2) Revision Details

a. Changes to Pass Coverage

Removal of Shodoshima Ferry and Shodoshima Olive Bus from the Pass

**Passengers using passes purchased on or before September 30, 2026, may continue to use Shodoshima Ferry and Shodoshima Olive Bus services.*

b. Changes to Pass Types

Discontinuation of the Four-Day and Five-Day Passes

c. Changes to Pass Fares

Fare revisions for Three-Day and Seven-Day Passes sold in Japan and through WEST-TR

3. Discontinuation of the KAGAWA Mini Rail & Ferry Pass

Sales of the KAGAWA Mini Rail & Ferry Pass will end on September 30, 2026.

Through its expanded partnership with Trip.com, JR Shikoku will make it even easier for more travelers to discover and enjoy the many attractions of Shikoku.

Product Overview

1. Pass Name

ALL SHIKOKU Rail Pass

**Effective for passes sold on or after October 1, 2026.*

2. Sales Period

Year-round

**For overseas sales:*

- MCOs are valid for three months from the date of issue.
- Passes may be exchanged from one month before the first day of use through the first day of use.

**For Domestic Sales:*

- Passes are available for purchase from one month before the first day of use through the first day of use.

**For JR-WEST ONLINE TRAIN RESERVATION, JR West's online reservation service for international visitors:*

- Passes are available for purchase from one month before the first day of use through the first day of use.

**For QR tickets purchased through the online travel agencies Klook and Trip.com:*

- The QR ticket can be activated once on the user's device within 90 days of the purchase date. Once activated, the ticket may be used for travel.

3. Validity

3 days, 7 days

4. Pass Details

- Unlimited travel in ordinary-class non-reserved seats on limited express, rapid, and local trains on all JR Shikoku and Tosa Kuroshio Railway lines.
- Unlimited travel on all rail and tram lines operated by Asa Coast Railway, Takamatsu-Kotohira Electric Railroad, and Tosaden Kotsu.

**The pass is valid on Asa Coast Railway's Dual Mode Vehicle (DMV), which operates on both railway tracks and public roads, except for services to and from Muroto on Saturdays, Sundays, and public holidays. Travel is subject to seat availability on the day of travel. Boarding may not be possible if all seats are occupied.*

**The pass is not valid on JR's Sunrise Seto sleeper train or on bus services operated by any transportation company.*

**In addition to the services listed above, passes sold on or before September 30, 2026, include unlimited travel on the Shodoshima Ferry route between Takamatsu and Tonosho and on all Shodoshima Olive Bus routes, excluding scheduled sightseeing bus services.*

- Refunds are available only for unused passes and, in principle, must be requested no later than the day before the first day of validity. Refund locations, fees, and other conditions vary depending on the method of purchase. Please ask a staff member for details.

6. Eligibility

The pass is available exclusively to foreign travelers visiting Japan under the "Temporary Visitor" entry status.
